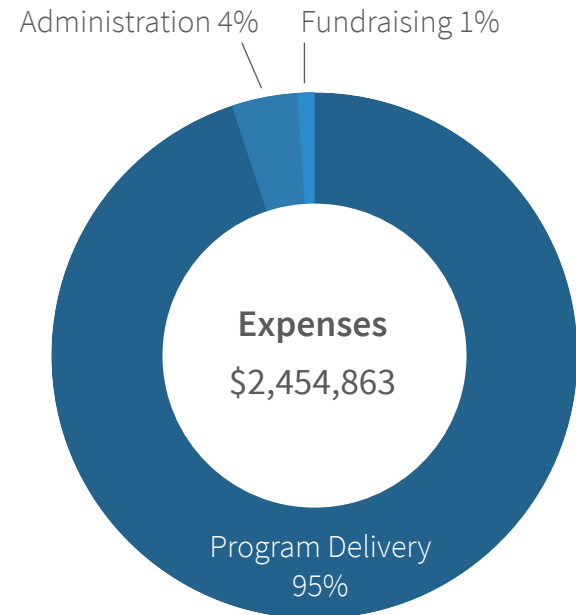
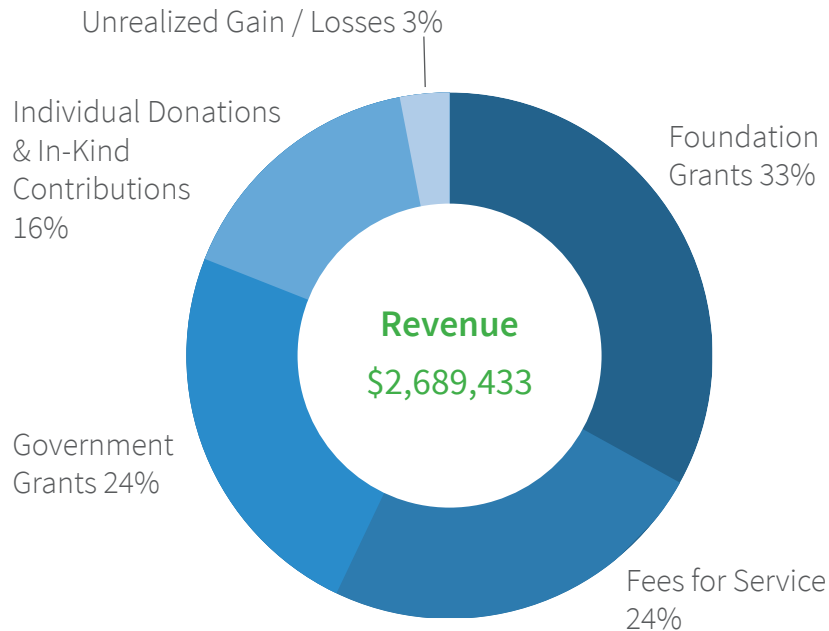
Meet Xenia,
